

## PPS EXTENDS DEADLINE FOR R1 MILLION IN BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

16 January 2012: PPS – the financial services company focused on graduate professionals – has extended the deadline for all university students studying towards a professional degree to apply for a bursary or scholarship to the 31<sup>st</sup> of January 2012.

According to Mike Jackson, CEO at PPS, the annual PPS bursaries and scholarships, which now total R1 million, form part of the company's ongoing effort to provide much-needed financial assistance to scholars across the country.
