

## STUDENT LIFE AT NMMU IMPROVES FOLLOWING R105,240 DONATION FROM PPS

Students at the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University (NMMU) can now enjoy a more comfortable learning environment following a R105,240 donation from PPS, the specialist financial services provider to graduate professionals, to help fund the refurbishment of its various student venues.

Joubert says that the Alumni Relations Office also received R27,620 to enhance the Alumni Meeting Room, which now offers a comfortable air-conditioned 16 seater meeting venue with sufficient space for the use of media equipment and an outside deck for social occasions.
